JANUARY 6 – THANKSGIVING / PRAISE

Thank the Lord for your relationship with Him. Express your love and adoration to Him. (John 1:12) Reflect on the Lord and thank Him for who He is, all He has done in our lives and for all He is about to do for LI and the Body of Christ. (Psalm 24, Psalm 103, Philippians 1:6) Humble yourself before the Lord and commit your time of fasting to Him. Ask Him to grant you success and to lead your prayers and time of fasting. (Psalm 37:5, Isaiah 58, Prov 16:3) Ask the Lord to reveal Himself afresh to us. (Matthew 11:27, Ephesians 1:17-21)

JANUARY 7 – REPENTANCE / FORGIVENESS

Ask the Lord to forgive you for sins you have knowingly committed. (1 John 1:9) Ask the Lord to reveal any unknown sin and offense you have committed against Him and others and then renounce and repent of them. (Psalm 139:23-24) Repent of any idols in your heart that have taken His place. Renounce those idols and declare Him Lord over every area of your life. (Examples of idols: Approval, Food, Money, Career, People, Possessions, Pets, Praise, Electronics, Social Media, Political Parties, Self, Exercise, News, Entertainment, Pleasure, Comfort) (Exodus 20:3, Psalm 135:15-17, Hebrews 13:5, Ezekiel 14:1-5) Forgive those who have offended, hurt, angered, used, and troubled you and then say a blessing over them. (Matthew 6:14-15, Matthew 5:43-48) Ask the Lord to cleanse you from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

JANUARY 8 – PURITY OF HEART / PERSONAL REVIVAL

Pray that the Lord will enable us and those in the Body of Christ to return to our first love who is Christ Jesus our Lord. (Ezekiel 36:26-27, Rev 2:4- 5) Ask the Lord for a heart of humility that is open and receptive to His counsel and obedient to His commands (2 Chronicles 7:14) Ask the Lord to create in us pure, clean hearts that we might see clearly. (Psalm 51:10) Ask the Lord to revive us according to His word, so His people may rejoice in Him. (Psalm 119:88, Psalm 85:6-11) Ask the Lord to pour out His Spirit in areas where we are dry, asleep, weary, or hardened. Trusting Him to bring life and strength to those areas, making us fruitful because we are nothing without Him. (Isaiah 44:1-3, Matthew 11:28-30, Ephesians 5:14, John 15) Ask the Lord to give us a hunger for Him, His Word, righteousness, truth and a desire to be holy. (Ephesians

JANUARY 9 – THE PURSUIT OF HOLINESS

Holiness is an intentional act, commitment, and desire to be more like Christ. Ask the Lord to reveal Himself afresh in our lives, in the life of our family and every believer. (Isaiah 45:5-7, Hebrews 1:3) Ask the Lord to show us His character, His ways and teach us His truths. (Psalm 25, Zephaniah 3:17, John 1:1) Ask the Lord to instill love for His Word as we make room for His Presence. (Col 3:16, John 15:7-8, James 1:22-25) Declare that "we are holy just as the Lord is holy". (1 Peter 1:15-16) Pray that we strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that trips us up. (Hebrews 12:1) Declare and decree that "we run with endurance the race God has set before us". (Heb 12:1) Decree and declare that "we keep our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith". (Heb 12:3) Pray that we persevere in faith against sin by submitting to the Lord's chastening and enduring it thankfully, (Hebrews 12:12-13)

JANUARY 10 – PERSONAL IDENTITY

Bind up the spirit of lust and declare that "lust will not have its way in the Body of Christ". Pray that the Body will walk in the Spirit so that it will not fulfill the lust of the flesh. (Galatians 5:16) Pray that the Body of Christ will abstain from fleshy lust which war against the soul by putting on Christ. (1 Peter 2:11, Romans 13:14) Pray that the Body of Christ would love what the Lord loves and hate what He hates and flee all forms of sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, enmity, drunkenness, orgies and the like. (Galatians 5:19-21, Colossians 3:5) Degree and declare that "no temptation has overtaken us except such as is common to man, but God is faithful, who will not allow us to be tempted beyond what we are able, but with the temptation will make a way of escape, that we may be able to bear it". (1 Corinthians 10:13) Declare that "the body is the temple of the Holy Spirit". (1 Corinthians 5:24) Pray against the spirit of confusion that would try to confuse people's identity and who they are in Christ. (1 John 2:16) Declare and decree, "we are not our own, we were bought at a price so glorify God in your body. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

JANUARY 11 – GOD'S WILL / PURPOSE / VISION

Pray that we be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so that we will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. (Col1:9-10) Ask the Lord to reveal the purpose and the plans He has for each person individually and enable us to walk in it. (Jeremiah 29:11, John 16:13) Ask the Lord to bring us into alignment and focus where we have lost focus and gotten off track (Philippians 2:13) Pray for His Kingdom to come and will be done in our lives as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:9-13)

JANUARY 12 – PROTECTION/DISCERNMENT

Ask the Lord to protect us, our family and our nation from all forms of evil both spiritually and naturally. (Psalm 91) Pray against deception and ask the Lord to help us to walk in truth, discerning between right and wrong, good and evil. (Psalm 91) Ask the Lord to protect us from sickness, disease, natural disasters, cyber security attacks, accidents, acts of violence, evil plotting and scheming of people, war, pestilence, economic shifting, lying and all forms of deception. (Psalm 91) Ask the Lord to help every member to guard their heart with all diligence, being careful of what they hear and see. (Philippians 4:8) Ask that Lord to deepen our trust in Him as we seek Him for His understanding, wisdom, counsel and perspective. (Proverbs 3:5-6) Pray that we would treasure God's counsel and wisdom through His word and make it a priority over the knowledge gained from social media, the news, people and other sources. (Proverbs 2:1-3) Pray that God would give us wisdom for every area of our lives so that we would be successful, avoiding the traps, pitfalls, and snares of the enemy. Seek wisdom concerning the following: what we are seeing and hearing, our ministry, our relationships, our careers, our finances, our roles and assignments, our businesses, our interactions, and our communication. (1 Corinthians 2:14, James 1:5, Matthew 10:16) Pray that we will grow in love, and that our love will overflow in knowledge, discerning those things that are excellent and without offense until the day of Christ. (Philippians 1:9-10, John 15:4) Ask that Lord to help us to see people the way He sees them, and not by their outward appearance. (1 Corinthians 1:27, 1 Samuel 16:7)



JANUARY 13 – HEALING – BODY, MIND, SOUL

Rebuke fear and anxiety in the name of Jesus Christ and declare that "the Lord is our hiding place; He protects us from trouble and surrounds us with songs of victory". Confess to the Lord that He never leaves us or forsakes us, and nothing is hidden from Him. (Psalm 32:7, Philippians 4:6-7, Deuteronomy 31:6) Pray that worry, anxiety and depression will not take root in our lives. Declare that we have the mind of Christ. Pray that our focus would be on the Lord who is our Peace. Ask the Lord for help and provision in every area of need and thank Him for the answer. (Matt 6:33-34, Colossians 3:2, Isaiah 26:3 Psalm 16:8, Zephaniah 3:16) Pray that healing will manifest in the lives of those who have been diagnosed with diseases, sicknesses and infirmities. Declare

that "the Lord was wounded for our transgressions, bruised for our iniquities, the chastisement for our peace was upon Him and by His wounds we are healed". Call for healing and reject fear, every negative report, and every negative thought. (Psalm 118:17, 1 Peter 2:24, Psalm 107:20, Malachi 4:2 -2) Ask the Lord for boldness to pray for the sick, oppressed, and broken, that He may move with power through you to bring forth their deliverance. (Matthew 16:17-18) Pray for those who have been rejected, forgotten, broken and abandoned. Ask the Lord to comfort them by giving them the revelation that He is with them. Ask the Lord to bind up their broken heart, and draw them into a relationship with Him, deepening intimacy and awareness of His Presence. Ask the Lord to surround the lonely with caring, loving individuals who will be a family to them. (Isaiah 40:29, Isaiah 42:3, Psalm 147:3, Psalm 68:6)

JANUARY 14 – HEART MOTIVES

Ask the Lord to search our hearts, try us, know our anxieties and see if there is any wicked way in us. Ask Him to purify our hearts. Ask Him to lead us in His way which is everlasting (Psalm 139:24, Psalm 86:11, Psalm 26:2) Ask the Lord to teach us His way and cause us to walk in His truth. (Psalm 86:11) Pray that we will keep our eyes focused on Him as He directs our paths so that our hearts will remain steadfast and single towards Him. (Prov 4:25-26) Pray that nothing we do will be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but that our motives will be to serve the Lord and others with a humble heart, desiring to see His goodness, victory, love, blessings, and strength manifest in the lives of others. (Philippians 2:3, 2 Timothy 3:5-7) Ask the Lord for a humble heart that seeks to esteem others, and is sensitive to His promptings to edify, serve and build others up (Psalm 51:17, Philippians 2:3, 1 Peter 4:10) Pray that the Lord will give us a fresh revelation of the following: His love for us, His love for others, our identity in Him and how we are knitted together as a Body. Ask Him to settle and ground us in this knowledge so that there would be no jealousy, competition, or strife among us. (Ephesians 3:14-19, Ephesians 1:3-6, Ephesians 1:15-21)

JANUARY 15 – RENEWING OF MIND

Pray for the Lord to give us the right attitude and perspective. (Psalm 51:10) Pray that every believer would allow the Word of God to transform their mind to develop the mind of Christ, which is without doubt, self-reliance, distractions, unbelief, fear, and depression. (Romans 12:2) Pray that the Lord would grant believers a love of the Word, and that bible study would become a daily part of their lives. (2 Timothy 2:15) Pray that believers would not only hear and study the Word, but also do what it says, developing the fruit of the Spirit. Pray that we will love what He loves and hate what He hates. (James 1:22, Galatians 5:22) Ask the Lord to help every believer to focus on His truth, what is right, what is pure, what is lovely and what is admirable and anything that is praiseworthy. May believers refuse to dwell on things that are vile, perverse, corrupt,

negative and deceptive and may they cast down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the true knowledge of God. (Philippians 4:8, Psalm 101, 2 Corinthians 10:5, Colossians 3:2) Pray that we would guard all our gates (what we hear, see, feel, say) and allow the Holy Spirit to have dominion in those areas. (Proverbs 4:23, James 3:5) Declare that "we have the mind of Christ as we allow the Holy Spirit to instruct us". (1 Corinthians 2:16, Philippians 2:5) Pray that believers would not fall into believing conspiracies, false prophecies, and false teaching. Pray that everything we see and hear would be tested by the Word of God and the Character of Christ. (1 John 4:1, Isaiah 8:12)

JANUARY 16 – MARRIAGES AND FAMILY

Pray that marriages are strengthened and restored. (Romans 15:5-6, Colossians 3:13) Pray for husbands and wives to walk in unity and that their hearts would be knitted together. (Matthew 18:19-21, Mark 10:8-9) Pray for conflict in families to be resolved so that there will be peace in the home. (Colossians 3:13) Pray that families would bear one another's burdens, be patient with each other, forgiving one another and walk in unity. (Colossians 3:13) Pray that each family unit would thrive as a safe place where family members receive love, acceptance and encouragement to go forward with God's plans for their lives. (Jeremiah 29:11) Pray that husbands and wives, children and parents, and family members would pray together and for each other, strengthening the bonds and taking each other's needs to the Lord in prayer. (Matthew 18:19-21, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, Psalm 50:15) Ask the Lord to deliver families from all forms of abuse, abandonment, divorce, oppression, addictions, homelessness, perversion, dysfunction, poverty, witchcraft, manipulation, control and negative cycles. (Psalm 34:17, Galatians 5:1, John 8:32, Matthew 10:1) Pray for Godly partners for singles who desire to be married. Ask the Lord to keep them pure from sexual immorality while they wait, and to allow them to find fulfilment in Him (2 Cor 6:14, Song of Solomon 3:5, Genesis 2:18) Pray for singles who do not want to be married to have joy and fruitfulness in every area of their lives. Ask the Lord to keep them from sexual immorality and turn their hearts toward seeking first His Kingdom and His righteousness. (Psalm 16:11, Isaiah 54:5, 1 Corinthians 7:32, 1 Corinthians 6:16-18) Pray that singles will give themselves wholehearted to the Lord and that they will be surrounded by fun, exciting, like minded friends and family that will help them to fulfill their purpose and assignments and drive out loneliness (Psalm 1, Hebrews 10:25, Matthew 6:33-34)

JANUARY 17 – CHILDREN, YOUNG ADULTS & SENIORS

Pray for the mental health of our children and young adults. (2 Timothy 1:7, 1 Peter 5:7, Isaiah 41:10) Pray that Youth will develop an intimate relationship with the Lord for themselves that is rooted and grounded in His love and truth and that their identities will be firmly established in Him. (Ephesians 3:17-19) Pray that the princes, powers, spiritual wickedness in high places would have no dominion over our children (Ephesians 6:12-18; 2 Corinthians 4:4) Pray that our children and young adults would foster godly friendships. and reject things, counsel and influences that are vile, corrupt, perverse and error. (Psalm 1) Pray that parents, family members and other believers would take the time to pray for and train the children in the way that they should go. (Deuteronomy 6:4-9) Ask the Lord to make the children and young adults resilient against the norms of society which are in opposition to Jesus Christ. (Roman 12:1-2, Joshua 1:9) Ask the Lord to give our children and young adults a spirit of excellence, causing them to do all things well, having favor with both God and people. (Daniel 5:12, 14, Daniel 6:3, Luke 5:52) Pray that the Lord will protect their coming in and their going out, that their days will not be cut short. (Psalm 121:8) Pray that our elderly will be taken care of, respected and honored. (1 Timothy 5:1-2, 1 Timothy 5:8, Exodus 20:12) Pray that the elderly will not be forgotten but that they will be acknowledged and celebrated for their wisdom, experience and knowledge. Exodus 20:12, Psalm 71:9, 1 Timothy 5:4) May the elderly find their place in the body of Christ, sharing their gifts, talents, wisdom, and abilities in building the church and its members. (Psalm 92:14, Titus 2:3-5, Matthew 28:19-20)

JANUARY 18 – ENDURANCE/FOCUS /PERSEVERANCE

Pray for grace to finish well (Philippians 1:6) Pray for strength and endurance to be victorious and fruitful through any challenge, trial, assignment and situation. (Romans 5:3-4, James 1:12, 1 Corinthians 10:13) Pray for focus to avoid distractions and derailments. (1 Peter 5:8, 1 Corinthians 9:24) Pray for boldness and courage to live out and fulfill all that the Lord has assigned for us to do individually, as a local body of believers and as the Body of Christ. (Hebrews 13:6)

JANUARY 19 – LEADERS OF LI & THE BODY OF CHRIST

Pray for the Lord to sustain, refresh, give strength, endurance, wisdom, knowledge and understanding in all areas of their life, with regard to their responsibilities and assignments. (Galatians 6:9-10, Ephesians 6:10, Joshua 1:7-8) Ask the Lord to protect them, their families and all that concerns them, so that they can focus on the work He has given them to do. (Isaiah 54:17) Ask the Lord to supply all of their needs and also give them the grace needed to lead His people. (Philippians 4:19) Pray that every leader will lead with excellence, humility, truth and integrity. (1 Peter 5:2-4, Proverbs 11:2) May every leader of LI and member have an attitude of honor and respect for our Visionary and Senior Pastor HRM and Lady Martha. May that attitude overflow into acts of kindness, love and service toward the fulfillment of the vision (Romans 13:7) May every leader be treated with respect, honor, and dignity. (Romans 13:7)

JANUARY 20 – PURSUE GOD

Ask the Lord to bring a cleansing in the hearts of Leadership in the Body of Christ, creating in them a clean heart and a right spirit, causing them to pursue holiness. (Psalm 51:7-12) Pray that the Body of Christ would recognize false prophets who come disguised as harmless sheep and false teachers who disguise themselves as angels of light. (Matthew 7:15, 2 Corinthians 11:13-15) Pray to push back against the ungodly, skewing the word, distorting the truth, appearing ok, but having no authentic love. (Matthew 7:15, 2 Corinthians 11:13-15) Judge a tree by the fruit it bears and uproot the enemies influence, dispelling any lasting fruit not planted by the Lord. (Matthew 12:33, Matthew 7:17-20, Matthew 15:13) Pray that leaders in the Body of Christ will be diligent to present themselves approved to God, workers who do not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. Pray that their doctrine will be sound and that the Body of Christ will not have itching ears. (2) Timothy 2:15, 2 Timothy 4:3-5 Pray that the Body of Christ will wake up and be vigilant to the tactics employed by the devil: discord, division, doubt, conflict, resentment between people, manipulation, faulty thought patterns (smokescreens and distractions) and partial truth. (John 10:10) Pray that every leader would put on the whole armor of God that they may be able to stand against the devil's schemes, for they do not wrestle against flesh and blood but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. (Ephesians 6:10-12)

JANUARY 21 – UNITY IN THE BODY OF CHRIST

Pray that every member and leader of LI come into unity with the Vision of LI, not being doubleminded, using their unique gifts, talents and abilities to contribute to its fulfillment. (Ephesians 4:16, Song of Solomon 2:15) Pray against all forms of division, factions, clicks, undermining, gossip and slander so that we may function in unity as one body, with one mind, moving in one direction. (1 Cor 1:10) Ask the Lord to reveal anything that we may be doing that may cause division in the church and then repent. (Example of things that bring division: Jealousy, accusation, gossip, slander, lying, manipulation, prejudice, racism, favoritism, competition, comparison, forming clicks, being a hinderance, being territorial, revealing secrets) Pray that LI and the Body of Christ would function as one body, with one Spirit, with one Lord, one faith and one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all. (Ephesians 4:4-6) Pray that the Body of Christ is quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to take offense and slow to get angry. (James 1:1-20) Pray against anger to promote loving one another and overlooking offense. (Proverbs 19:11) Pray that LI and the Body of Christ will come to the revelation that there is power in agreement because the Lord is in the midst of them. (Matthew 18:19-20, Ephesians 4:4-6) Pray that all will serve in their roles and assignments in love, humility, with perseverance and steadfastness. (Luke 9:62) Pray for renewed strength as a church, loving one another as the Father loves us, making covenant to achieve the greater works for the Kingdom of God as we move from glory to glory. (Isaiah 40:31).

May every leader and member submit one to another, growing in faith together, with our eyes on the prize, moving together in synchrony, not breaking ranks, executing the works of the Kingdom with precision and accuracy, leading to fruitfulness. (Psalm 133:1, Hebrews 13:7, John 15, Ephesians 4:16) Pray that every member and leader see the treasure each one holds, esteeming one another in love, because without love we are a clanging cymbal. (2 Corinthians 4:7, Romans 12:10) Pray for faith to be heightened as we press toward the new thing the Lord is doing, not allowing the challenges that go along with the journey to cause doubt and abandonment. (Hebrews 11:6, Galatians 6:9, Romans 8:18, 1 Timothy 1:19) Pray that there would be signs, wonders, miracles and Holy Spirit manifestations, as we serve, and may every person walk in the supernatural power of God. (Isa 44:26a, 1

Corinthians 4:20)

JANUARY 22 - THE BODY OF CHRIST + LIFE INTERNATIONAL

Pray that every department and every member fulfill their divine earthly assignments. (Philippians 1:6) Pray for the spirit of holiness to be prevalent in our churches by becoming a sacrificial, countercultural, transformed, and committed church. (Romans 12:1-5) Pray for transformation and renewal of our cities by the Spirit of God. (Proverbs 15:1-7) Pray that LI and other churches will demonstrate the Lord's love and unity by building relationships with people different from ourselves. (John 17:20-23) Pray against the spirit of fear, worry and anxiety and declare that believers will walk in power, love, and a sound mind. (2 Timothy 1:7)

JANUARY 23 - EVANGELISM / CHURCH GROWTH / SOULS

Pray for a heart to reach those who do not know Him. (John 3:16, Ezekiel 33:11) Reflect on your life and ask the Lord to forgive you if you have not been prioritizing the sharing of the gospel with those who are perishing. Repent of this and commit to making the sharing of the gospel a priority in your life. (Matthew 28:19-20) Ask the Lord for there to be a mighty revival in our church and cause us to experience growth in numbers and spiritual maturity as we end the year. (Acts 2:47) We pray that LI and our affiliates will know that God is a God of all nations, who is working through cities to take the gospel to the world by giving us grateful hearts, gospel faithfulness and fruitfulness, gracious engagement, and servants to send out. (Colossians 1:3-8) Pray that every member of LI will become disciples of Jesus Christ and also make disciples of Jesus Christ. (Matthew 28:19-20) May the Lord help LI to be fruitful in impacting our community and our nation for Christ. (Matthew 28:19-20) May LI make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Ask the Lord to add to our LI Family daily. (Matthew 28:19-20). Pray that the Lord will draw those who have backslidden and have been held captive by their disobedience. (Jeremiah 3:22) Remove the blindness from the eves of those who have been blinded by the god of this word. (2 Corinthians 4:1-4)

JANUARY 24 – FINANCIAL BREAKTHROUGH

Thank God for meeting every need of Life International and its members. Ask Him to supply abundantly so that we can clear all debts in 2025. (Philippians 4:19) Ask the Lord to grant us wisdom to manage resources effectively and make decisions that will lead to financial freedom for our lives and this church. (Prov. 21:5) Ask the Lord for favor with creditors, donors, and other stakeholders. Open doors for partnerships that will help us pay off all debts (Luke 2:52) Ask the Lord to open the heavens over our lives and our church and release a supernatural blessing that will cancel every debt in 2025. (Deuteronomy 28:12) Ask the Lord to bless every member/partner owned business as well as the business that members/partners are employed. (2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 140:8) Ask the Lord to intervene in our communities so that it would be a safe, and prosperous place to live and grow our families. (2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 140:8) Pray against gun violence, gang activity, human trafficking, corruption, homelessness and drug trafficking and addictions in our communities. (2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 140:8) Ask the Lord to pour out His spirit in our cities and communities and break the stronghold of the enemy that would keep the people from coming to the knowledge of Christ and from living healthy, prosperous and abundant lives. (2 Corinthians 2:4, John 10:10, 2 Corinthians 10:5) Pray that the Lord would shine His light into every dark place. (John 8:12) Pray for those who are marginalized, mistreated, and forgotten (Psalm 34:18, Romans 8:35-39, John 3:16-17) Ask the Lord to pour out His Spirit over our schools, universities, hospitals, nursing homes, (1 Timothy 2:1-7, Ephesians 6:18) Ask the Lord to guide the hearts, decisions, policies and judgements in our local government, police departments. (Isaiah 59:12-15, 2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 34:17) Ask the Lord to bring revival to our nation, to restore us and to bless us. (Psalm 80:3) Ask the Lord to turn the hearts of the Leaders and the people toward Him, to reverence Him. (Psalm 75:6-7, Proverbs 11:11) Plead the blood of Jesus over every position that has been appointed or elected that they may not be used by the prince of the power of the air. Pray for justice in the city that will help marginalized people who are trafficked, homeless, broken families, refugees, and even those marginalized in church. (Zechariah 7:8-12)
